

King's College

King's College has a policy of accepting a limited number of overseas students at all levels and has a record of success with students from different ethnic backgrounds. In the case of students whose families are expatriate New Zealanders with overseas residency or business commitments, application for entry will be through the normal channels. Many such students are enrolled at an early age and families make arrangements for interviews at the usual time, prior to final acceptance by the College.

All aspirant Year 9 students are required to sit Entrance and Classification tests. These are normally scheduled for May in the year prior to starting at Year 9 and take place at the College. Where intending students are not New Zealand residents and require a Student Visa to study in New Zealand, certain prerequisites must be met. The College is a signatory to the New Zealand Ministry of Education Code of Practice for the Pastoral Care of International students.
